Heart attacks have early signs and symptoms. These beginnings may occur in 50% of patients. If recognised, people can be treated before heart damage occurs.





Chest pressure, squeezing, aching or burning



Shortness of breath



Feeling of fullness, nausea or vomiting



Anxiety



law pain, back pain, or pain that travels down one or both arms



Excessive fatique or weakness
