
The virus spreads when respiratory droplets from a sick person's nose or mouth gets into a healthy person's nose, mouth or eyes.

Apply soap and water to your entire hand.






If you are displaying symptoms, the spread of the virus.

Preventative measures



Avoid exposure with people who have cold or flu-like symptoms



Stay home if you are sick



Thoroughly wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based sanitiser or hand rub that contains at least 60% alcohol.



Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands



Cover your nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing. If you do not have a tissue, use your elbow/sleeve



Do not share food, utensils, cups or towels
